INDEPENDENT STUDENT VERIFICATION WORKSHEET

To receive financial aid, you must complete a process called Verification. Verification requires you to submit signed copies of your (and your spouse's) financial documents (signed copy of Federal income tax returns) and provide other information and documents to your college Financial Aid Office. After a comparison of information on these forms and documents and the information on the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), you may need to make corrections using your SAR, or your college may send corrections electronically.

What you should do:

- Fill out all sections of this form and return it to the Financial Aid Office.
- Submit all other required documents to the Financial Aid Office.
- Complete this process as soon as possible so that your financial aid won't be delayed.
- If you have any questions about filling out this worksheet, talk to someone in the Financial Aid Office.

A. Family Information
