CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: Applications for any or all programs are due in the Campus Abroad Office no later than **NOVEMBER 21, 2008**.

The Campus Abroad Program has entered into a partnership with either the American Institute for Foreign Study or ACCENT International to conduct residential educational programs abroad. At Foothill-DeAnza, a committee comprised of two faculty senate appointees (one from each campus), the Coordinator of the Program, and the Dean of International Education review the applications and make recommendations to the appropriate division dean.

Assignments are based on the following criteria:

1. Subject matter expertise as required by the program of study designated for the overseas campus,
2. Variety of courses a faculty member is able to teach based on minimum qualifications or equivalency,
3. Balance in subject matter the faculty member brings to the entire Campus Abroad teaching team,
4. Ability to work easily with others,
5. Minimum competence in the language of the country is desired but not required.
