June 2010	CSU LDTP 2nd Cycle Results Due	Receive results from CSU review panel.	Approved courses will be issued T-CSU identifiers. Results distributed to division deans and CCC reps.

Note 1: Courses must have official approval by the local curriculum committee and be available in “approved” format on the C3MS system prior to the submission deadline so that the outlines can be transferred electronically to the transfer outline repository “OSCAR”. Unofficial outlines or outlines in “submission” mode may not be forwarded for articulation.

Note 2: Courses must receive approval by the UC Office of the President for general transferability in order to be submitted to individual UC campuses for course-to-course articulation.
