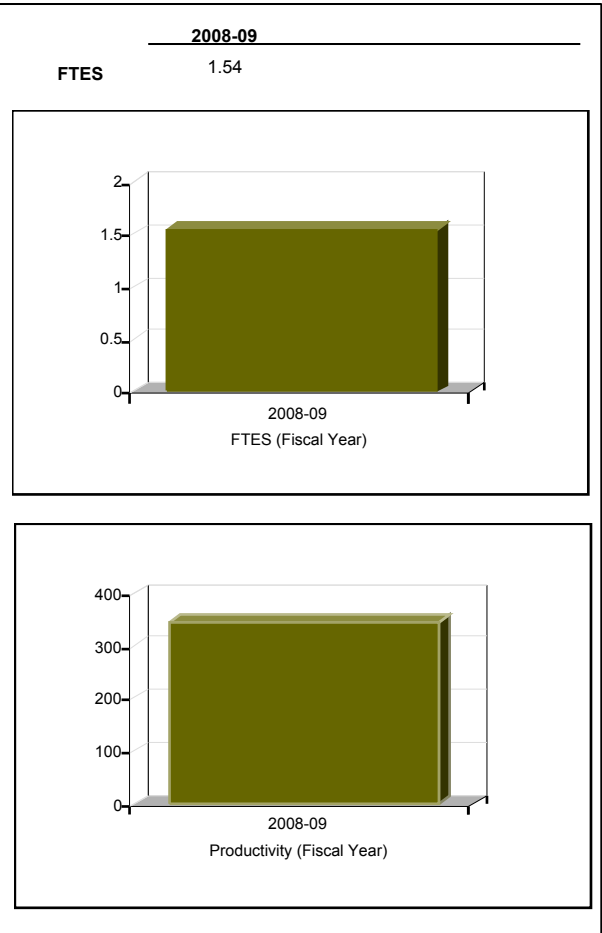

Sum of teaching load factors for Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters by assignment type, excluding reassignments.

**Productivity:**  
Four-term total WSCH / four-term total FTEF, excluding reassignments.

**Reassigned FTEF:**  
Sum of load in 994, 995, 998, and 999 courses.
