❖ Minimum Proficiency in Mathematics for Local AA/AS Degrees: The Mathematics department has updated the language for the minimum proficiency in mathematics for local AA/AS degrees, which was approved by CCC on April 23rd. This new language will go into effect with the 2019-20 catalog. If you have any questions, please contact your Curriculum Reps. Below is the full text of the new proficiency statement:

MATH 105 or 180 or any MATH course approved for Foothill GE Area V, Communication & Analytical Thinking.

❖ Credit by Exam: At the April 23rd meeting, CCC approved a process by which a faculty member submits a course to be included in the list of Credit by Exam courses published in the college catalog. The document outlining the process will soon be uploaded to the CCC Policies & Resolutions webpage.

❖ Auto-informing Students for Degrees and Certificates: At the April 23rd meeting, CCC held a third read of a CCC Resolution in support of auto-informing students who have completed the requirements for a degree or certificate. The discussion included a change in the language and intent of the resolution, from "auto-awarding" a degree or certificate to "auto-informing" students. CCC decided to continue the discussion and bring the resolution back for a fourth read before bringing it to a vote, so there is still time to provide your feedback, via your CCC Reps.
