- ❖ Program Deactivation: On May 7th, CCC approved the deactivation of the Certificates of Achievement in Traditional Photography and Digital Photography, effective 2019-20. The AA degree and Certificate of Achievement in Photography will continue to be offered.
- ❖ Auto-Informing Students for Degrees and Certificates: At the May 7th meeting, CCC approved a resolution supporting the implementation of a local process to automatically inform students who have completed (or will soon complete) the requirements for a degree or certificate. - ❖ Honors Course Prerequisite: At the May 7th meeting, guests from the Honors Institute and Equity departments engaged in discussion with CCC regarding the prerequisite currently listed on all Foothill honors courses that limits enrollment to students who are Honors Institute participants. The Equity & Education Committee recently approved the removal of this prerequisite from all honors courses, and CCC considered the possible effects, benefits, and challenges of its removal.
