- * Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT): On June 4th, CCC approved the application for the Nutrition and Dietetics AS-T degree, which will be sent to the FHDA Board of Trustees for approval at an upcoming meeting.
- Credit by Exam Petition Form: At the June 4th meeting, CCC held a second read of a draft form for students to submit when requesting to use Credit by Exam for a course. Discussion continued regarding the process for a student to pick up and submit the form. CCC decided to bring the form back for a third read before voting. To see the updated draft and provide feedback, please contact your CCC Reps.
- Credit for Prior Learning: Dolores Davison, VP of ASCCC, joined CCC at the June 4th meeting to continue discussions regarding Credit for Prior Learning. Davison briefed the group on the recent increase in interest in Credit for Prior Learning at the state level, and provided insight regarding what's to come over the next year, including changes to Title 5 language and guidelines for colleges related to recently-passed SB 1071, which requires colleges to adopt local policies to award Credit for Prior Learning for military veterans. Another recently-passed bill, AB 1786, requires the state Chancellor's Office to expand Credit for Prior Learning beyond military learning. CCC is likely to continue discussions on the topic in the fall, and we will continue to keep you informed via the Communiqué!
