News & Announcements:

- Resolution Authorizing Remote Teleconference Meetings: At the November 16th meeting, CCC reaffirmed this resolution, which was originally approved on October 5th, so that CCC may continue to meet virtually (via Zoom) through the end of fall quarter.
- ❖ Winter Quarter CCC Meetings: Related to the above, the main topic of conversation at CCC's November 16th meeting was planning for a return to holding in-person meetings on campus, likely to include an option for folks to attend virtually. Per Brown Act requirements, to conduct any committee business at a meeting a quorum (50% + 1) of voting members must attend in person. The group brainstormed ways to best hold successful hybrid meetings for all attendees, including utilizing a conference room that has the most ideal tech setup, and using an online sign-up sheet/tool to ensure a quorum will be in attendance. The group also discussed Brown Act requirements for Division Curriculum Committee meetings, which are the same as those for CCC and include appointing an ASFC Rep to each Division CC.
