News & Announcements:

- ❖ **New Certificate Proposal:** CCC approved the following proposal on March 7th. Please contact your Curriculum Reps and/or the faculty author if you have questions or comments.
 - ◇ Certificate of Achievement in Non-Destructive Testing D. Lennox

- ❖ **New Certificate Application:** At the March 7th meeting, CCC approved an application for the following certificate, which will be sent to the FHDA Board of Trustees for approval at an upcoming meeting.
 - ◇ Certificate of Achievement in Research, Design and Development for Global Good K. Pereira

- ❖ **Degree Deactivation:** On March 7th, CCC approved the deactivation of the Associate in Science in Business Administration for Transfer Degree (ADT), which will go into effect for the 2023-24 catalog. This ADT has been replaced by the new Business Administration 2.0 ADT.

- ❖ **Addition to Course Family:** CCC approved the following addition to an existing course family in Fine Arts and Communication, effective 2023-24:
 - ◇ Acrylic Painting Family—ART 19G Outdoor Landscape Painting

- ❖ **Addition to Credit by Examination List:** The Apprenticeship division has approved the following course as available for credit by examination (effective spring 2023 quarter): APPT 143A.

- ❖ **Guiding Principles for Equitable CORs:** At the March 7th meeting, CCC held a first read of this document, which will serve as a resource for faculty when creating or updating CORs from an equity perspective. The document is the result of a year's worth of discussion at CCC and will return for a second read and possible action at the March 21st meeting. In addition to the first read, the group discussed the need to come up with a process for adoption of the document across all academic divisions.
