REQUEST TO CHANGE MTEC COURSE DISCIPLINE DESIGNATION

The Co-Directors of the Foothill College Music Technology Program request that all Music Technology (MTEC) Course Outlines of Record be modified to exclusively designate the discipline as “Commercial Music.”

These courses have historically permitted the discipline of “Music,” but this was due to the fact that the Music Technology courses were originally created as support courses for the General Music degree. Because these programs are now separate, and MTEC courses are no longer valid support courses for the Music degree, it no longer makes sense to include “Music” as a designated discipline for MTEC courses. Music discipline faculty may not meet the minimum qualifications to successfully teach commercial music courses that are highly dependent upon professional work experience in the commercial music industry.

Two courses, MTEC 57A & 66A, include "Multimedia" as a discipline, which is left over from when they were cross-listed with MDIA courses. This discipline will be removed, as well.
