FOOTHILL COLLEGE College Curriculum Committee Resolution to Support Blanket Distance Education Addendum

Whereas, the health and safety of Foothill College students, faculty, and staff is of primary importance;

Whereas, moving to remote modalities for on-campus courses is consistent with the advice of the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office and the County of Santa Clara Department of Public Health;

Whereas, the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office has requested that colleges submit an Emergency Blanket Distance Education Addendum to satisfy the requirements included in Title 5, section 55206;

Whereas, the college has pledged to work with faculty to find reasonable alternatives for course content that must be delivered in person (e.g., physical education courses, clinical course hours, lab courses);

Resolved, that the Foothill College Curriculum Committee support the submission of an Emergency Blanket Distance Education Addendum to the California Community College Chancellor's Office that will apply to all on-campus courses, with the understanding that the college will rely on faculty to determine the most appropriate delivery method.
