\*Note: The SSN provided through the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals is not for use on the FAFSA. Please attend a workshop for guidance on the Dream Application.

### PARENTS

1. Social Security Number – On either application, if parent does not have one, enter zeros.
2. FSA ID (if applicable)
3. Financial Record from 2017, if parent(s) had an income, including:
  - Tax forms- 1040 (A, EZ) & W-2
  - Records of untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income
  - Bank statements
