COMMENDATIONS & STRENGTHS:

- PRC commends strategic efforts to increase the applicant pool.
- PRC commends the effort to increase enrollment through dual enrollment pathways.
- PRC commends excellent student success rates for all students.
- PRC commends high completion rates for all students.

SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT:

- PRC has concerns with labor market situation/low wages and continued trend of lower enrollment, productivity.
- PRC suggests the department explore opportunities to do more than one cohort per year to serve more students.
- PRC suggests the department explore possibility to run as noncredit short term vocational track.
- PRC suggests the department look at EMS (do noncredit and credit together) to serve more students.
- PRC would like more detailed information about major focus on increasing enrollment when it doesn't seem like the program can accommodate it.
