AB705 is about *throughput*

Throughput is the percent of students who successfully complete transfer-level English within one year of their first English class.

- **Fall 2016:** Multiple measures pilot.
 - **Throughput 68%**
- **Fall 2017:** Multiple measures implemented.
 - **Throughput 66%**
- **Fall 2018:** Multiple measures and fewer below-transfer-level sections offered.
 - **Throughput 73%**



Trends in First English Class Attempted vs. Throughput:

English 1A or 1A Honors	43%	40%	64%
English 1S	5%	7%	10%
