# Vision Aligned Reporting is not...

- A change to fiscal reporting—program outcomes not tied to future funding
- A replacement for MIS data submissions
- A replacement for SSARCC for those programs that use it
- An initiative Elaine came up with

# Vision Aligned Reporting and Vision 2030

- State Chancellor's Office identified goals to become more student-centered and equity-minded, streamlining policies, processes, and funding
- New way for college programs to collect and report consistent data on their activities
- 2017: Vision for Success
- 2022: Governor's Roadmap
- 2023: Vision 2030

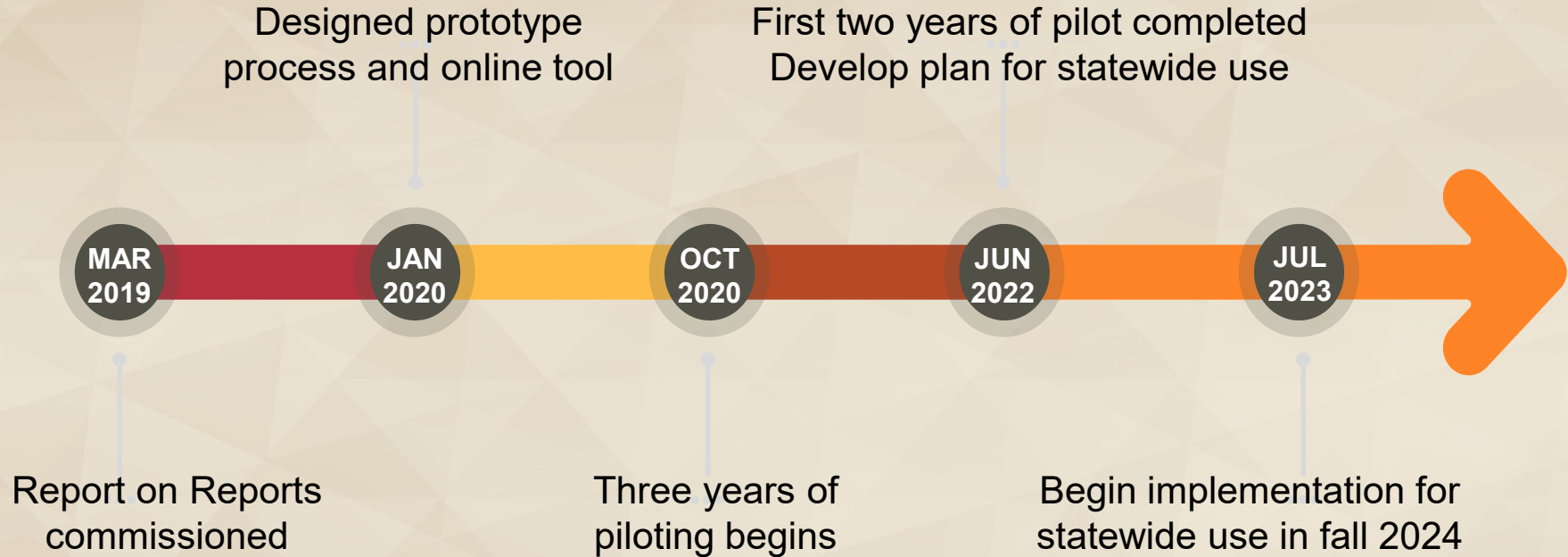

# Vision Aligned Reporting Purpose

- For system
  - Align the Vision 2030 goals to college programs and activities
  - Make it easier to share, interpret, discuss, and act on data from the 116 colleges
- For college
  - Facilitate institutional ability to evaluate, learn, plan, and evolve to better support student success
  - Promote cross-campus, cross-silo strategies for aligning and leveraging activities, programs, and funds
  - Longer term goal is to integrate with MIS reporting and replace reporting requirements for most programs

# Vision Aligned Reporting Development



Note: The Chancellor's Office convened an internal workgroup that convened between January 2020 and June 2023 that designed, piloted, and refined this new comprehensive reporting structure for college programs. This workgroup was replaced with the Vision Aligned Reporting Governance Committee that began meeting in July 2023.



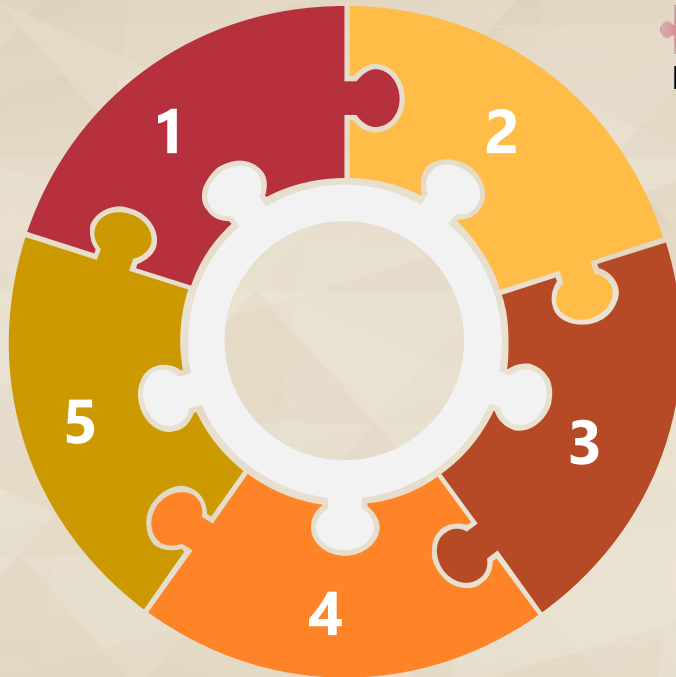

# Vision Aligned Reporting and Vision Goals

- **How are colleges working to close achievement gaps?**
- Goal 1: Completion
  - Increase degree and certificate attainment
- Goal 2: Transfer
  - Increase transfers annually to a UC or CSU
- Goal 3: Unit Accumulation
  - Reducing avg number of units accumulated among students earning degrees
- Goal 4: Workforce
  - Increase students who report being employed in their field of study

# College Narrative Prompts

- 3 highlights that served the goal of closing equity gaps
- 3 concrete steps taken to braid program efforts/funds to increase impact
- 3 most effective strategies/tactics
- 3 important barriers college faced
- 3 top changes college will make to achieve goal

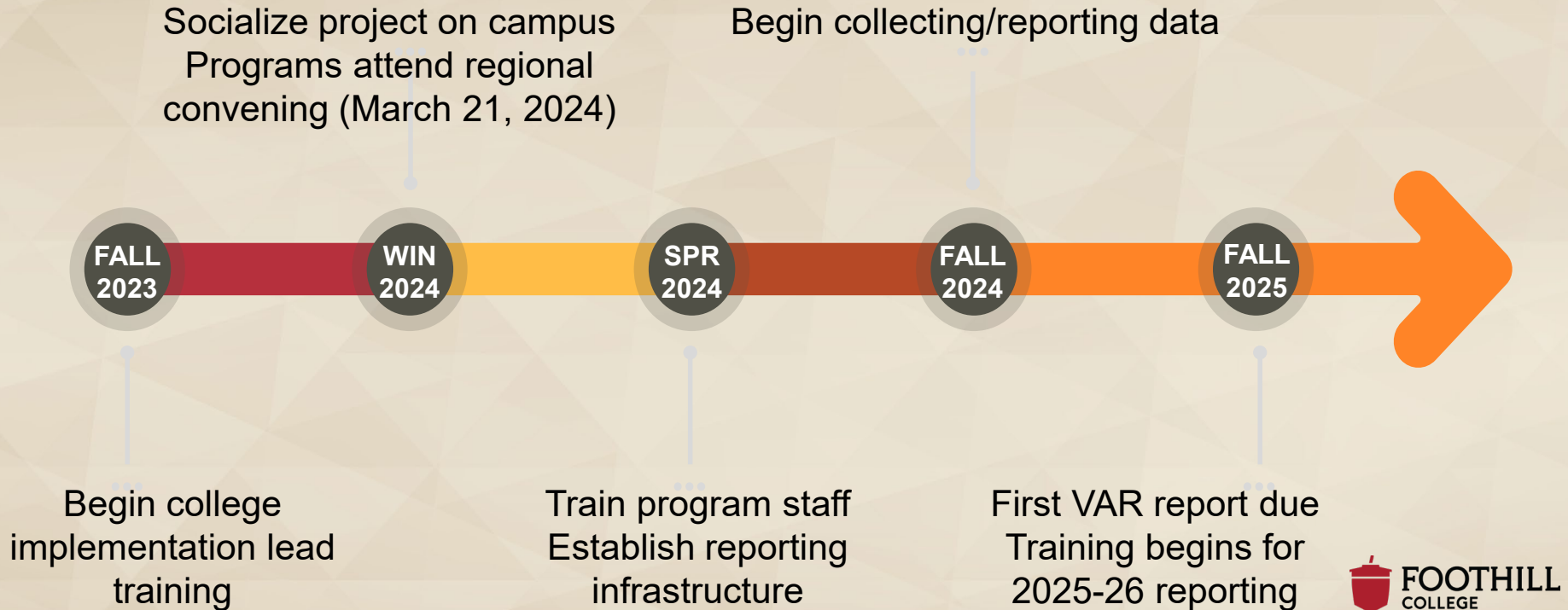
# Vision Aligned Reporting Program Data

  - Aggregated student-level activity data
- Year 2: 2025-26
  - CWIDs of each student served by program activities
- Disaggregated by Black/African American, Hispanic/Latina/o/e, and economically disadvantaged

Note: Year 1 submission due December 2025; Year 2 submission due December 2026

# College Implementation Lead Role

- Design, organize, and convene an appropriate workgroup;
- Develop and oversee an implementation process appropriate to the college's context and culture that works across silos;
- Facilitate productive conversations about integrated college priorities and goals, ensuring programs have a voice in the process; and
- Elevate critical updates, decisions, and questions to appropriate groups and/or institutional leaders.

# College Senior Leadership

- Administrators supporting student services and budget areas to ensure time and resources for programs to identify how they will collect the reliable data needed to achieve the project's goals.

# Statewide Implementation Team

- Provides training resources, guidance, and lessons learned throughout the implementation phase
