## **Associate Degree Requirements:**

Units required for Major: 36

English proficiency: ENGL 1A, 1AH, 1S & 1T, ESLL 26 or equivalent.

Mathematics proficiency: MATH 17, 105, 108 or equivalent.

A minimum of 90 units is required to include:

- Completion of one of the following general education patterns:
  - o Foothill General Education,
  - o CSU General Education Breadth Requirements or
  - o the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC)
- Core courses (24 units)
- Support courses (12 units)

**NOTE:** All courses pertaining to the major must be taken for a letter grade. In addition, a grade of "C" or better is required for all core and support courses used for the degree.

The **courses listed BELOW** are generally offered as online courses at least once every two years. Please see Schedule of Classes for verification.

**NOTE**: Students having difficulty attaining an associate degree because of timing or availability of classes should consult with a <u>counselor</u> to submit a petition for course substitution.

- HIST 17C History of the United States from 1914 to the Present (4 units)
