PROGRAM GOALS

The PRE-STEM Summer Institute (PSI) is a free three-week program for incoming Foothill students to

- 1. Gain exposure to and skills in data science as a tool for social impact.
- 2. Build confidence in math in preparation for precalculus or calculus in the fall.
- 3. Collaborate with others on social impact projects.
- 4. Connect with other students who are interested in STEM fields and entering Foothill in the fall.
- 5. Get ready and support for starting Foothill College in the fall.

PROGRAM BASICS



- interested in pursuing a STEM major (especially computer science, engineering, physics, or math)
- first time enrolling at Foothill College with no previous degrees
- live locally to Foothill College
- continuing in the PRE-STEM learning community (see below) in fall 2022
