1. Presentation:

Peter Murray, PSME Dean, described the multifaceted program, Building for a Green Future, being develop by his Division. Funding proposals are being submitted. New courses are being developed for the targeted audience, displaced professionals, technicians and UCSC transfer students. NASA and many industry participants will be involved.

2. Zimride Rideshare Portal Update:
