Application and Transcript Deadline: APRIL 21 by 5:00pm PST

Our Veterinary Technology Application is now available online. Please read through the instructions (items 1-13) so that you are able to submit a complete application by the deadline.

Order your transcripts early, as it may take up to a month for receipt of your documents.

Before you apply

Application Requirements

3. Make sure you're ready and eligible to apply by reviewing all of the program prerequisites and requirements. Be sure to review the sample application to get a thorough understanding of what to expect once you open up your official application. If you are unsure of your qualifications, please make a counseling appointment.

<u>Required Documents</u>: Please obtain the following documents.

Official Foothill College and/or De Anza College transcripts are not required. Request Official Electronic Transcripts (e-transcripts) from <u>ALL other</u> colleges attended that show completion of GE and Prerequisites. Enter all college coursework completed where appropriate on application.

Additional Documents: Please include the following required documents, if applicable:

- Documentation of completion of CSU or IGETC General education
- High school AP Math score of 3 or higher if applicable

Transcripts

Transcripts not received by the application deadline, April 21st, may result in disqualification. Transcripts from Foothill and De Anza colleges do not need to be ordered. If you are a previousyear program applicant, and we received all your other college transcripts, you do not need to submit new official electronic transcripts to Foothill College Admissions and Records unless you have completed new coursework.

For new students or previous applicants with new coursework, request college transcripts that show completed GE and Prerequisite courses. Typically, registrar offices or registration departments at the corresponding college will assist you with this. Please note that unofficial copies will not be accepted and may automatically disqualify you. You must request that electronic transcripts or e-transcripts be sent to Foothill College Admissions and Records at: fhtranscripts@fhda.edu. If your school doesn't offer electronic option, please send sealed official transcript hard copies to:

Please note that if you received an Associate's Degree from a California Community College and/or Bachelor's degree from a UC or CSU, completion of your General Education requirements will be waived. **Waiver does not include prerequisites.**

If you have completed prerequisite coursework outside of Foothill College, and the coursework you have completed is **not** included in the FH Transfer Equivalency guide (below), you will need to petition through our counseling office. Please make an appointment with a Foothill College counselor. The counselor will process the petition to determine whether or not your course meets equivalency for substitution.
